



The property was completely and tastefully renovated in 2007, and was originally part of an old olive oil farm.

To the property belongs two large terraces, with a lovely view, of which one has a small outdoor kitchen.

The other terrace can easily be shielded off form the surrounding properties, to ensure absolute privacy.

On the property is a small tool shed, which also has plenty of room for outdoor cushions when you are not using them. Current owner has built a small outdoor shower in connection with the shed.

The main heat source is a closed fire place.

The house is completely move-in ready.

SURROUNDING AREA

The property is located only a couple of kilometers from the town of Vinci, birth place to the famous artist, Leonardo da Vinci.

About one km. from the property lies the small village of Fornello, where there's a coffee bar and a pizzeria.

In Vinci you will find a good selection of restaurants, shops and a small supermarket. The town has a weekly market and there are many cultural offers throughout the year.

The area is the perfect base for excursions, whether you want to go to the beach, go sightseeing or want to visit a vineyard or an olive mill.

The cities, Florence, Pistoia, Montecatini Terme and Prato, are all less than an hour drive from the property - the same goes for the airport of Florence and Pisa, while the airport of Bologna is only an hour and a half away.
